Mrs. Brenda J. LaGrone was born October 23, 1951, to the late Horace Brocks and Minnie Lee Kelly. She passed away on December 7th at the age of 69 at Christus St. Michael Health System in Texarkana, Texas.

Mrs. LaGrone obtained her Associates in Nursing in 1977 at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, and dedicated 40 years of service as a registered nurse and in support of several health initiatives. She was an active member and served as deaconess at the Greenville Missionary Baptist Church in Stamps, Arkansas.

She was a loving wife, a caring mother, and a friend and mentor to all that knew her. Her life was dedicated to service and the betterment of her community, evidenced in her work as a community activist for the Stamps Cleanup Project, volunteering in voter registration drives, active participation in several Susan B. Komen Race for the Cure events, and a member of the Lafayette County Leadership Council. Her pastimes included gardening, traveling, and spending time with her grandchildren.
