



## Mr. Eddie Hall

August 6, 1943 - January 4, 2024

Deacon Eddie M. Hall was born August 6, 1943, in Lewisville, Arkansas, to the late Booker T. Hall and Alice Hall. He departed this life on Thursday, January 4, 2024, at his home in Hope, Arkansas while on Hospice.

At an early age, he began his Christian journey at Union Hill Baptist Church. Eddie was an ordained Deacon at Union Hill.

He received his formal education in Lewisville; and was a graduate of Foster High School.

Eddie was united in holy matrimony with his late wife, Daisy Hall, in April of 1963. From this union, four children were born. Two of his four children preceded him in death—Tony and Darryl Hall. He also had another child, from a previous relationship, that preceded him death—Eddie Wayne Hall.

Eddie later married Wanda Wells on August 5, 2017. Wanda is the mother of Ariel Hollingsworth (Michael) and Fealander Wells, and grandmother of Isaiah, Kaven, and Michael, Jr.

He was well-known in the community. He was an active member of the NAACP, the local Fire Department as a volunteer, and the Voting Registration Committee.

Those left to cherish his wonderful memories are his wife of five years, Wanda Hall of Hope, AR; two daughters, Angela Johnson of Carrollton, TX; and Synthia (DeAllen) Hobbs of Navarre, FL; three granddaughters: Natasha Hall-Moore, Elcena Hall, and Gabrielle Hobbs; three grandsons: Tony Hall, John Hall, and DeAllen Dexter; three sisters: Clemerstine (Rev. Jewell) Jones, Shirley T. Ensley, and Minister Eleanor (John) Briggs; one brother, Deacon Alfred (Loretta) Hall; and a host of great grandchildren, nieces, nephews, other relatives, and friends who will miss him dearly.

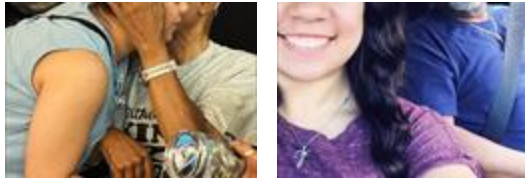
