



## Mrs. Gladys L. Williams

October 19, 1926 - October 21, 2018

Ms. Gladys L. Williams ;92 yrs., of Willisville, AR, passed away, October 21st at Wesley Medical Center in Wichita, KS. She was born October 19, 1926 to the late Pearl E (Beasley) Moss and Reuben Moss. She was the seventh of nine children.

Gladys' education started at Sweet Home Elementary School, Willisville, AR. She attended Nevada County Training School (renamed Oak Grove High School) in 7th through 12th grade. She continued her education at Johnson's Business School, Little Rock, AR. She worked for Hibble and Hibble Law Firm as a secretary. In 1947, she married Earmon Williams. Their union brought forth four children: Hardy Williams, Patricia A. (Williams) Allen, Harold B Williams (deceased), and Othell T. Williams. She joined Pleasant Grove Missionary Baptist Church at age 12. After marriage and children, she moved her membership to New Hope Missionary Baptist Church. At New Hope she was a church clerk #1 and Sunday school teacher.

After the demise of her husband, she moved her membership back to Pleasant Grove. There she was a member of the Choir, Mission Society, and kitchen staff. She was Associate Matron of Honey Grove, Forget Me Not Chapter of the Order of Eastern Star, a member of Golden Circle chapter of Stephens, AR. She was a faithful church member for 80 years.

Gladys loved gardening, flowers, sewing, cooking (umm umm good), reading

and animals.

She drove the Prescott Senior Citizen bus and did volunteer work at the center. After declining health, she moved to Wichita, KS. She resided at the Manor Care Nursing facility. Her care was under the watchful eyes of Patricia and Hardy. She made many friends and participated in all activities.
