Mr. Jimmy Wayne Harris, 69 yrs. old, of Dallas, Texas, formerly of McNeil, Arkansas, passed away Thursday, July 18th, 2024, at the V.A. Medical Center in Dallas, Texas.

Jimmy Wayne Harris was born on April 7th, 1955, in McNeil, AR to the late and great Charlie & Marna Harris in 1968. The family moved to Detroit, MI where he graduated from Central High School in 1975. After which, he joined the US Army as a Utility Helicopter Mechanic.

When the family originally moved to Detroit, he met Evelyn Reed and they had Dwayne Lee Reed, their pride and joy, in 1971. In 1976, Jimmy met Carolyn Sue Glasper at a house party where he said when she came in the door it was a light shining around her and he knew that was his wife. Due to Carolyn refusing his proposals, the couple was later married in 1979. They moved to Dallas, TX in 1982 and later Nikki Denise Harris was born. However, she passed away soon after. In 1989, Carolina Harris was born. Being a proud veteran, Jimmy worked for the VA Hospital in several capacities and retired in 2009.

Jimmy is preceded in death by his daughter, Nikki Denise Harris, his parents, Charlie & Marva Harris, and his lovely wife, Carolyn Harris.
