Mr. Leroy Green, Jr. was born on March 6, 1945, to the late Leroy Green, Sr. and Laura Green Lewis, in Stephens, Arkansas. On the morning of Sunday, June 8, 2025, Leroy peacefully transitioned into eternity in Dallas, Texas, surrounded by love.

Leroy grew up in Stephens, Arkansas, and graduated with the Class of 1962 from Carver High School. At an early age, he united with New Union A.M.E. Church in Ogemaw. He proudly served his country in the United States Air Force before pursuing higher education at AM&N in Pine Bluff, Arkansas (now the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff). There he earned his bachelor's degree in social science, embarking on a path of service and education.

Leroy began his career as a 6th grade teacher in Kankakee, Illinois, where he spent 2 ½ years shaping young minds. He later brought his compassion and insight to roles as the Illinois State Mental Hospital and as an Intake Counselor for the Department of Corrections in Joliet, Illinois.

In 1968, Leroy married Mary Carter and to this union, they were blessed with two children. Angela Green Jones and Quincy Green.

Leroy's life was marked by his love of family, his distinctive personality, and his flair for living. After retirement, Leroy returned to his roots in Stephens,

Arkansas, where he spent several years before relocating to Dallas, Texas. A lifelong fan of the Dallas Cowboys, Leroy took great pride in cheering for his team, whether during their highs or lows. His passion for football was matched only by his love for reading, music, and stepping out in sharp attire, complete with his signature hats and glasses.

Preceding Leroy in death are his parents; two brothers, Eddie Lee Green and Fred Douglas; brother-in-law, Charles Sanders; and niece, Debra Ann Sanders Warner.
