Mr. Lester Jetton, 80 yrs. old, of Magnolia, Arkansas, passed away Thursday, July 21st, 2022, at his residence.

Lester was born on November 24, 1941 in Camden, AR. He attended school at Fairview and graduated in 1959. He then joined the National Guard and was sent to Fort Knox, KY to learn to drive tanks. After his discharge he went to work for Southwestern Bell Telephone Co., now AT&T, where he stayed for 33 years.
