Linda Rene Murray was born June 6, 1954, in McNeil, Arkansas, to the late Sgt. Roosevelt McCall and the late Evelyn Ferguson McCall.

Linda accepted Christ at an early age at Kendrick Chapel Baptist Church in Waldo, Arkansas.

Linda grew up in many places in the United States. Her father traveled with the United States Army. She lived in Tacoma, Washington, Killeen, Texas, and Orleans, France.

She graduated from Lee Senior High School in Marianna, Arkansas. Linda continued her studies earning a diploma in LPN studies from Northeast Vocational Technical School in Springdale, Arkansas, a BA in Philosophy & Religion from the University of Arkansas at Fayetteville, an Associates Degree in Nursing from Philander Smith College in Little Rock, Arkansas, a MS degree in Operation Management, and a MA in Religious Studies at Liberty University in Lynchburg, Virginia.

She was ordained and licensed as a minister in 1996, then ordained as a Pastor in 1998.

Linda was united in Holy Matrimony to Lee H. Murray on December 24, 1974.

To that union, three children were born. Linda traveled with her husband during his commitment to the USAF. They lived in Cheyenne, Wyoming, Fort Worth, Texas, Fayetteville, Arkansas, Columbus, Mississippi, Fort Walton Beach, Florida, Memphis, Tennessee, and finally, Jacksonville, Arkansas. She moved to Jacksonville in 1991, where she worked as a Registered Nurse until 1998. She then worked beside her husband in the ministry until his death. She continued to work in the ministry until her passing.

Linda transitioned home on Tuesday, January 23, 2024.

Linda was preceded in death by her father, Sgt. Roosevelt McCall, her mother, Evelyn McCall, and her husband, Lee Murray.

She leaves to mourn her passing; three children: Kisa (Valentino) Warren, Karla Ware, Kia Swinson all of Jacksonville, Arkansas; seven grandchildren: Khagji, Valentino II, Kezia, Kamara, Kaylee, Marcus III, and Major; two sisters: Sandra McCall of Dallas, Texas, Janice Fraction of Marianna, Arkansas; one brother; Gerald (LaShan) McCall of Little Rock, Arkansas, and a host of nieces and nephews.
