Rosie Lee, “Sutta Gal” which her family compassionated named her, was the first-born of the first set twins to the late Earlie “Dick” and late Estella “Babe” Fields on December 17, 1943, in Emerson, AR Rosie Lee attended McMittress High School in Emerson, AR. She was a member of Pleasant Home CME Church which she continued to attend when she came home to visit in between the impromptu services she had with her daughters. She relocated to Dallas in 1959 with her husband, Wilbert Kearney. To this union, four children were born.
