Warren Douglas Charles was born on June 16, 1940, in Ogemaw, Arkansas, to Mark Charles and Fannie Wheeler Charles. He was the youngest of eleven children.

Warren received his education at Carver High School in Stephens, Arkansas, and was a proud member of the graduating class of 1958.

In 1960, he joined the United States Air Force. After serving for two years, he moved to California, where he lived for several years. In 1972, he returned to Arkansas and began working at Georgia Pacific in Crossett. He later attended Oil Vo-Tech School in El Dorado, Arkansas, and was hired as a machinist at Vought in East Camden. His final place of employment was International Paper Company in Camden, Arkansas.

Brother Charles was known as an intelligent, hardworking man. At an early age, he joined New Union AME Church, where he remained a faithful, dedicated, and supportive member.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Mark and Fannie Charles; his brothers, Odis Charles Sr., Jesse Charles Sr., Walter Charles, Mark Charles Jr., and Leroy Charles; and his sisters, Ila Mae Hunter, Beulah Hildreth, Callie Mae Hildreth, and Jettie Mae Charles.
